Only animals exhibited will be allowed to be sold. All livestock trailers must be parked in designated areas only.

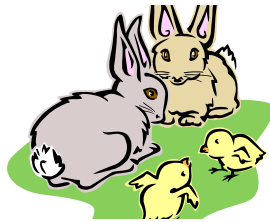
Registration, fees and entry form must be sent to the Superintendent at the above address by July 1, 2023. Entries will not be accepted after July 1, 2023. Please use the Poultry and Rabbit Entry form located at the end of this department. **MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: ROSEMARY REAMS.** All entries limited to Michigan exhibitors only! Entries will be accepted only to capacity of the pens.

Ionia Free Fair is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged articles prior to, during, or after the Fair.

Entry fees are \$.50 per head for poultry and waterfowl, and rabbits and \$2.00 for female with nursing litter or hen with brood under six (6) weeks and fees must accompany entry. Entry fee money is used for purchase of feed and bedding and upgrading of pens.

Note: Youth may enter up to 5 birds free.

Please indicate on entry form where rabbits will be housed, either 4-H or open class building. Any rabbit not worthy of show will be sent home. All rabbits must be ARBA recognized breeds and varieties. Cages will be assigned in order of entries. All entries are final, no changes or substitutions will be allowed. **RABBIT ENTRIES: NO PERSON MAY ENTER MORE than two (2) animals per class per breed or two (2) does with litter per breed.** All animals must be legibly tattooed in left ear. Feed and feeders and water dishes provided. Placing ribbons awarded. Rosettes awarded to Best of Breed six class and Best of Breed four class.



All Youth poultry will be housed in the open class poultry barn. All birds will be judged, No exceptions! Any bird not worthy of show will be sent home. All entries are final. No changes or substitutions will be allowed. Exhibitor may scratch entry prior to judging, entry fee not refundable. The exhibitor or his representative must handle own animals, poultry and waterfowl during the judging. No birds or animals are to be taken from the grounds before release time without permission. All birds must be vaccinated against diseases. It is recommended that poultry be vaccinated against bronchitis and new castle disease at least 30 days prior to Fair. All poultry shown at public exhibition in this state shall have originated from US Pullorium-typhoid test within 90 days of the movement to the public exhibition. **COPY OF US PULLORUM-TYPHOID TEST MUST BE PROVIDED TO SUPERINTENDENT PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF BIRDS.** A US Pullorum-Typhoid testing station will be available Sunday morning for those exhibitors unable to secure prior testing. Advanced testing is strongly encouraged due to shortage of time on placement day. Tester will charge a testing fee. Any birds or animals showing symptoms of disease will not be permitted to enter or remain on grounds. Every effort to keep the Poultry Department building in a sanitary condition and every precaution will be taken against loss by fire, disease, or theft, but the Ionia Free Fair will not be responsible for loss of stock at the fair. All birds and rabbits must be entered in the name of the bonafide owner. He or she must be the breeder of such variety or varieties entered. All entries will be judged according to the American Standard of Perfection rules. No person may enter more than two (2) Cocks, two (2) Hens, two (2) Cockerels, and two (2) Pullets, per class, per breed. Hens with Brood enter as old Hen. Placing ribbons and rosettes awarded as stated in the Champions Division.
